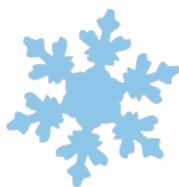

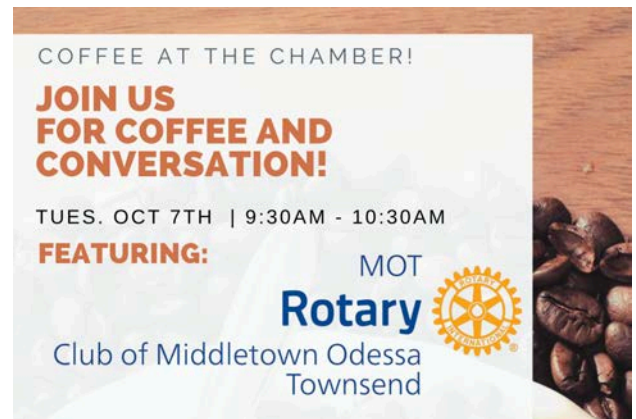
Connection Around Every Corner

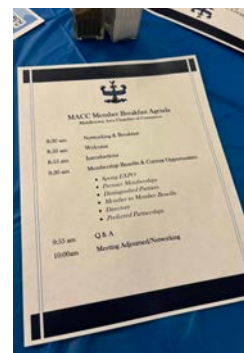


Quarterly Member Breakfast
