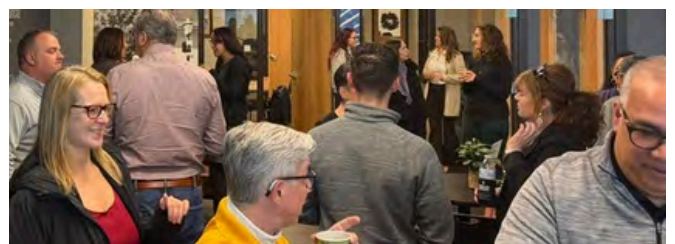

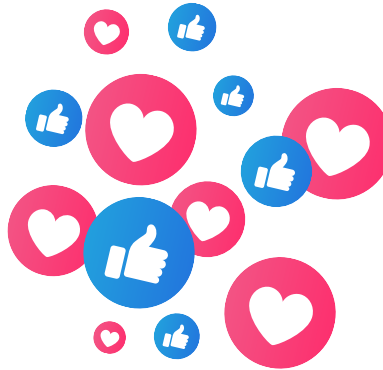
The MACC was honored to serve as a community partner in support of the Middletown Family YMCA and its unwavering mission to uplift and serve our community.

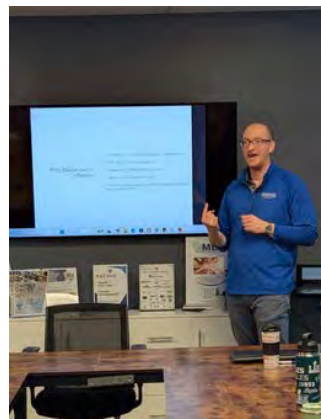

March continued the momentum of 2026 bringing meaningful opportunities to connect, collaborate, and strengthen our business community.

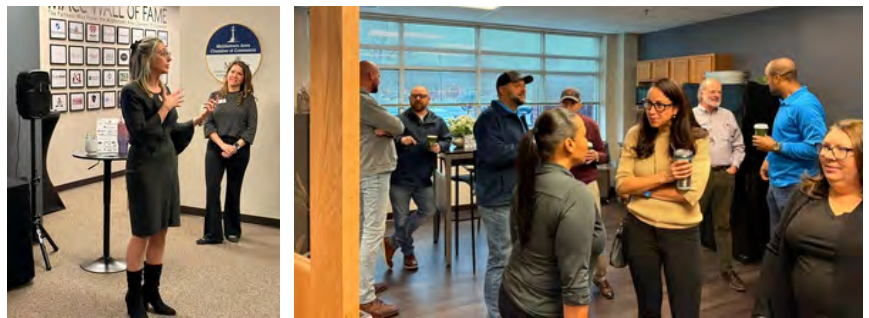

# SPRING EXPO!

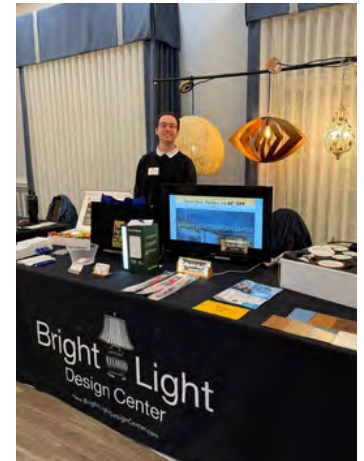
